

Phenophase Matching




Directions:

Step 1: Cut out the plant images and text boxes on page 2.

Step 2: On page 3, put the images of plant life cycle events in the order you think they will appear throughout the year. (Early Spring (#1) to late Fall (# 8))

Step 3: Match the phenophase descriptions (text boxes) to the life cycle events by placing them below the image they describe.



Early Leaves Unfolding: Only a few leaves have completely unfolded from their buds (less than 5%)

Early Autumn Leaf Color Change: Only a few leaves have changed color (<%5) **First Fruit:** First fruits become fully ripe or seeds drop naturally from the plant on three or more branches Middle Flowers: Half or more of the flowers are fully open or releasing pollen on three or more branches

All Autumn Leaves Dropped: All or most leaves have dropped Middle Fruit: Half or more branches have fully ripe fruit or the seeds are dropping naturally from the plant 50% Autumn Leaf Color Change: Half or more of the branches have leaves that have started to change color All Leaves Unfolded: All or most leaves are fully unfolded
